British Schools Championships

Location: Hawley and Hornley, near Farnborough, Hampshire.

Separate races for girls /boys of each school year
Years 5-13 inclusive.

THIS AREA IS EMBARGOED to pupils wishing to compete in the Championships.

Medals: First 3 individuals in each race, first 3 teams (of 3) in each race and first 3 schools in each category.

Trophies: Winner of each team race, and winner of each category of school.

Overnight Accommodation (Saturday night): Floor space will be available at nearby school.

Entries: To be made by the school, but there is no minimum number of competitors from each school.

The Championship Event on the Sunday is open to any school or college pupil born between 01/09/1990 to 31/08/1999 (inclusive) who has completed at least 3 orienteering courses prior to the Event.
