Wednesday 1 July

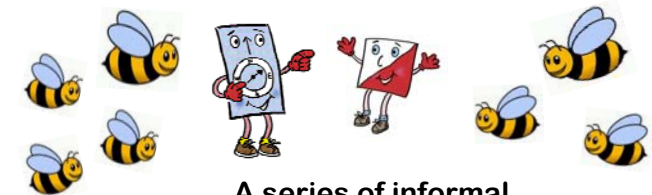
Overscourt Wood, Siston Lane, just south of Siston village, between Kingswood and Bath
